

Last Will and Testament

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That I, A. H. SCHUBERT, of Hays County, Texas, being of sound and disposing mind and memory and above the age of nineteen years, do make and publish this my last Will and Testament, hereby revoking all Wills and testamentary writings, if any, by me at any time heretofore made.

1.

I direct that all my just debts shall be paid.

2.

I give and bequeath to my grandchildren, ARNOLD SCHUBERT and VIOLA SCHUBERT the sum of Fifty (\$50.00) Dollars each.

3.

I hereby will, give, devise, and bequeath unto my daughter, ELIA SCHAPIRO, and my daughter, LILLIE SCHALEBEN, all of the rest and residue of my property, of whatever nature real or personal, at the time of my death, to be divided between them as follows: My daughter, ELIA SCHAPIRO, is to receive 75% of my Estate that remains after the above bequest, and my daughter, LILLIE SCHALEBEN, is to receive 25% of my Estate after the above bequest.

I do hereby nominate, constitute, and appoint my son-in-law, MAX SCHAPIRO, the Independent Executor of this, my Will, and direct that no bond shall be required of him and direct that no action shall be had in the County Court in relation to the settlement of my said Estate then the probating and recording of this, my Will, and the return of statutory inventory and appraisement and list of claims of such Estate, and of all claims due or owing by me at the time of my death.
